

ARTHROSTIM

The ArthroStim is a handheld tool our Chiropractors use to aid in performing adjustments and spinal manipulation therapy. Quick pulsating (around 12 pulses per second) in an injured area causes nerves in our brain and spinal cord to reevaluate the condition of certain systems in our body. This process does not irritate pain receptors so our brain is able to send positive feedback to the affected area and begin healing those systems efficiently and appropriately.

Who Benefits From the ArthroStim?

Anyone can benefit from this tool, however with such a wide variety of patient needs, sometimes the manual adjustment a chiropractor can provide might not be as effective or efficient. More specifically

- Infants and young children
- Individuals with acute or extreme pain
- Particularly sensitive individuals
- Individuals who dislike being "cracked"
- Elderly individuals

Treatment

Typically, your chiropractor might use the ArthroStim Instrument by itself or in combination with other adjusting techniques, but of course this will depend on the approach they feel is best for your specific treatment.
